Recommended Plantings

The Board has developed the following list of recommended nursery stock after consultation with the Condominium's landscape contractor and a number of horticulturalists. All of these specimens grow well in this region, are disease and pest resistant, can be maintained by the landscape contractor, and are the proper scale for the size of Regents Square yards. Please note that the planting of any variety of Bamboo anywhere on Condominium property is strictly prohibited.
